










MEXICO: THE GATEWAY OF THE AMERICAS

Through its network of free trade agreements, Mexico has privileged access to 46 countries (more than 1,200 million people).










A SOPHISTICATED ECONOMY





- ✓ Over 41,600 jobs in Arkansas depend on trade with Mexico





Total est. 2017: \$847 Million USD










EXPORTS FROM MEXICO TO ARKANSAS



NAFTA MODERNIZATION: Show trade nowadays and economic new conditions...

...From a trilateral perspective (negotiations must be trilateral) ...

... Based on three main topics:

- All three parts must recognize NAFTA has benefited all three.
- Acknowledgment that after 23 years of its existence, there are things that can be improved.
- The negotiation must remain with a win-win-win focus.



... Anything that could damage or jeopardize all that has been gained with NAFTA must be rejected. (duties, quotas or any other form of trade tariff).








MODERNIZATION OF NAFTA: TIMELINE.

7 rounds of NAFTA Renegotiation... Signed by the Presidents of US, MX, and the Prime Minister of CA (Expected before Dec 1st)

USMAC will enter into forcé (No sooner than three months from the date of the las country's notice)



United States Trade Representative published the United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement Ratified by the legislatura of all three countries (90
