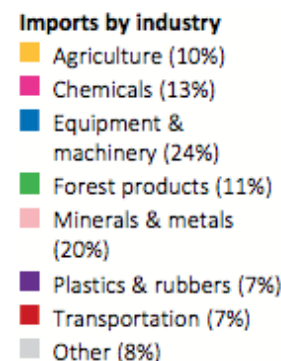

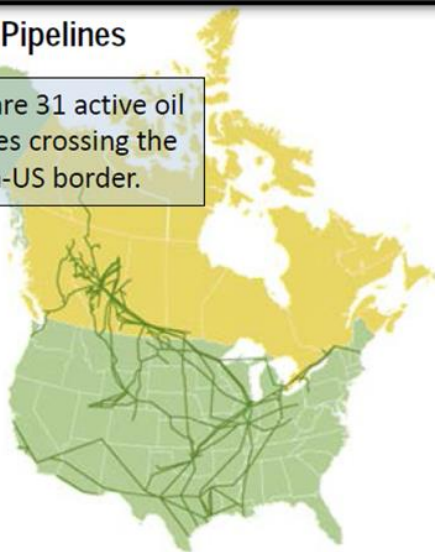

There are 70 operating oil and gas pipelines and over 30 major electricity transmission lines that cross the Canada-U.S. border

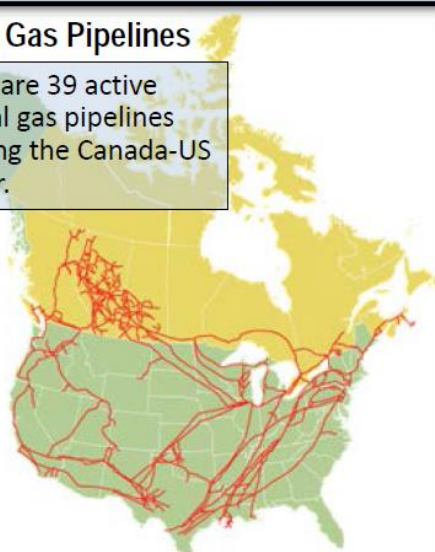
Liquids Pipelines

There are 31 active oil pipelines crossing the Canada-US border.



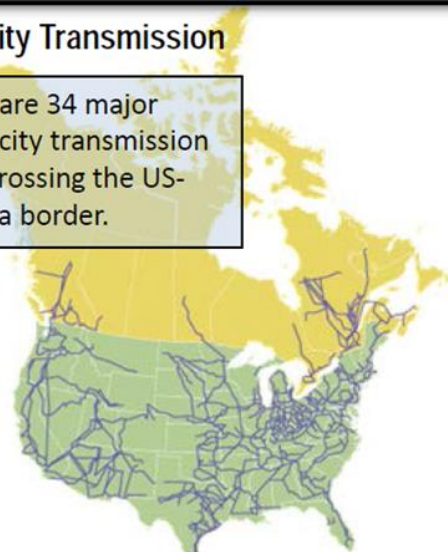
Natural Gas Pipelines

DEFEND NORTH AMERICA

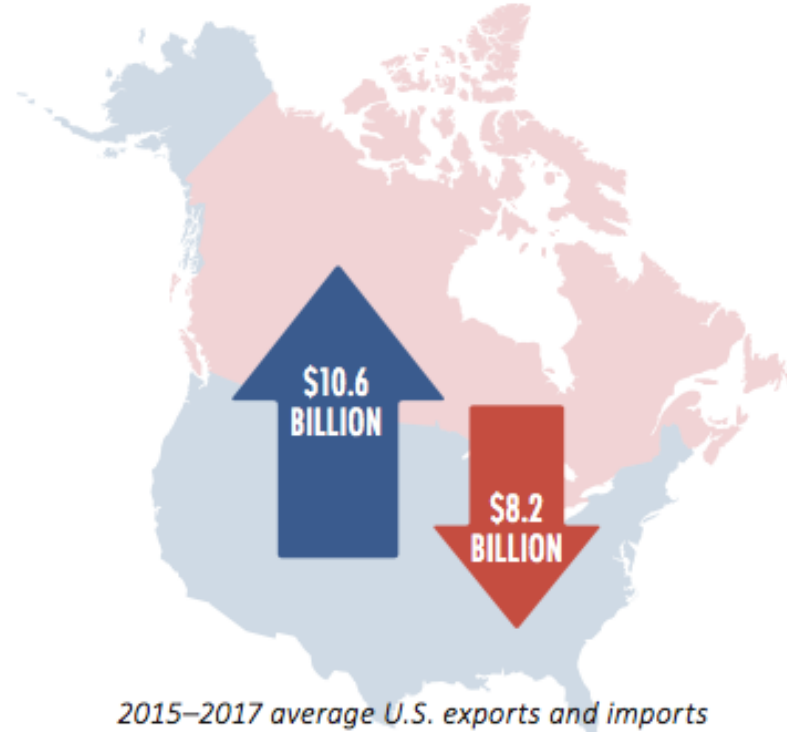
- Since 1940 we've coordinated **CONTINENTAL DEFENSE**
